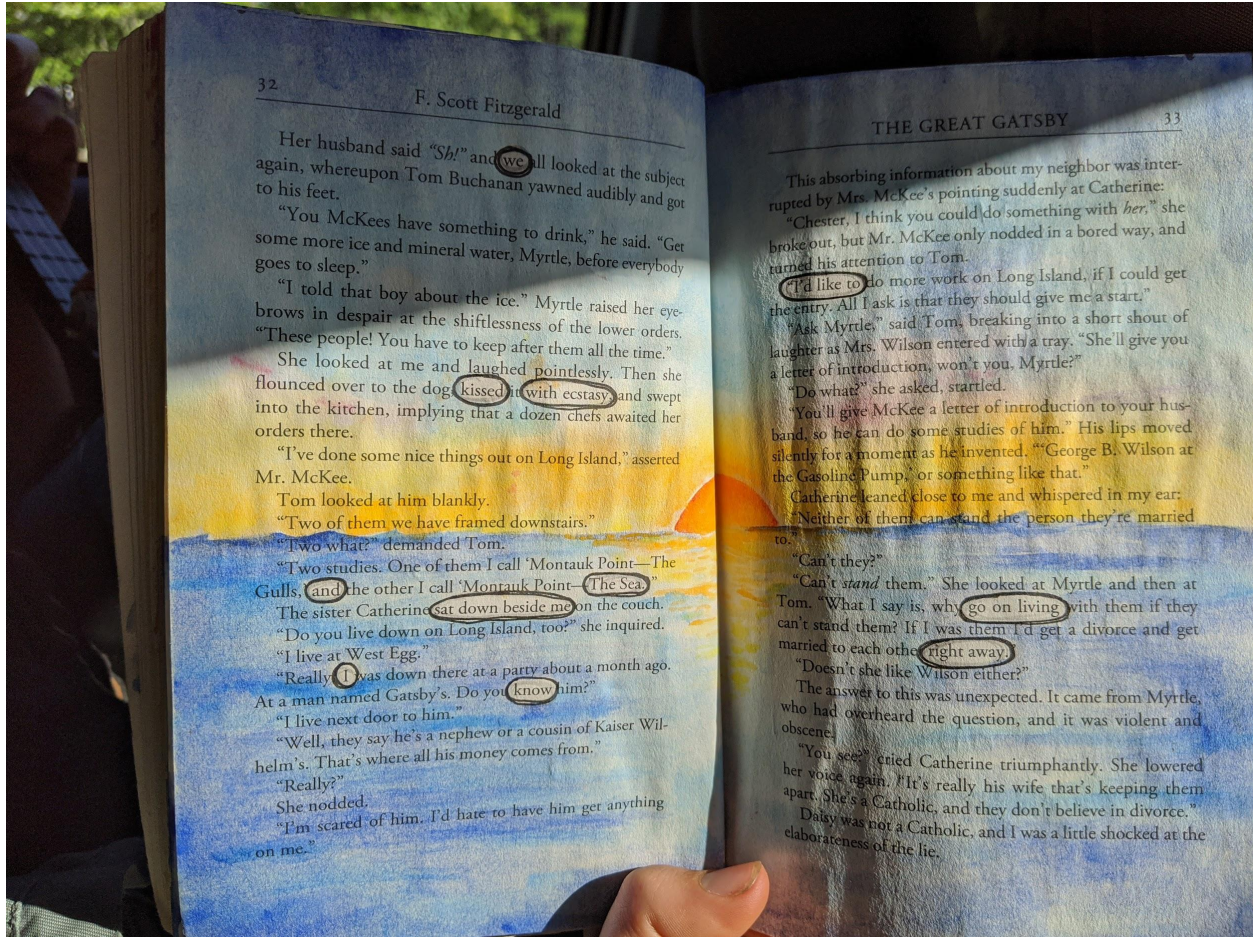
**Materials I need to get:** fluffy white felt
