Digital Art 2: Multiplicity Compositing Project

The goal of the multiplicity project is to seamlessly integrate multiple images of the same person in one background. The subject can be you, a friend, family member (or pet! The pet will be tricky though- it won't follow directions from you as well as a human).

Criteria:

- 1. Include at least 5 images of the subject
- 2. Create a sense of depth with the subjects (have some in the foreground, some in the background and some in the mid ground)
- 3. Some of the subjects must be interacting with each other. For example, you could have two subjects in a conversation, fighting, shaking hands, etc.
- 4. Seamlessly integrate the subjects into the background. It is up to you how you accomplish this, either with layer masks or another technique.
- 5. Keep everything on its own layer- do not flatten the image.

EXTRA POINTS! ...if you can create a theme in your image, so not just a bunch of subjects standing or sitting around...develop a back story and create a scene where something interesting is happening or about to happen.

Another idea is to look at recreating a famous painting with multiple subjects, such as Seurat's *Sunday Afternoon on the Island of La Grande Jatte*. Or Goya's *The Third of May* and try to recreate that!
